Monday Night Racing

It's an exciting new year for Newington Ski Club racing! New this year will be Racing Team Hats for all members who race in five (5) Monday Night Races at Mount Southington. Monday night racing begins December 21st, so sharpen those edges! Also, new this year all members will receive a \$7.00 race fee rebate at the end of the season for each race you enter, no matter how many times you race. And new too, is that the Club is committing to a junior program, and is offering to pay for the juniors' race fees at On Snow (stay turned for the details).

Newington Ski Club has been a force in the Connecticut Ski Council racing scene, and we encourage you all to come out and give it a try. No racing experience is necessary, and boarders are welcome as always. We compete in a Giant Slalom in which each participant gets two (2) runs, and your best run counts towards earning the Club and the individual points. Although you must be at least 18 years of age to participate in Monday Night Racing, beginners to experts revel in the fun.

The State Championship Races will be held January 13, 2010 for the GS and February 10, 2010 for the Slalom, both at Mount Southington. The Downhill, Snowboard and Cross Country races will be March 5, 6, and 7, 2010 at Mount Snow during the On-Snow Winter Carnival.

The cost: 4 day of skiing/riding for \$199 plus tax if purchased by December 15, 2009. If purchased between 12/16/09 and 1/15/10, the price for the same 4-page is \$219 plus tax. You may re-load the card in increments of 2, 3, or 4 additional days at the original purchase price (initial orders before December 15 - each additional day costs \$49.95 plus tax; initial orders placed December 16 - January 15 - each additional day costs \$54.95 plus tax.) 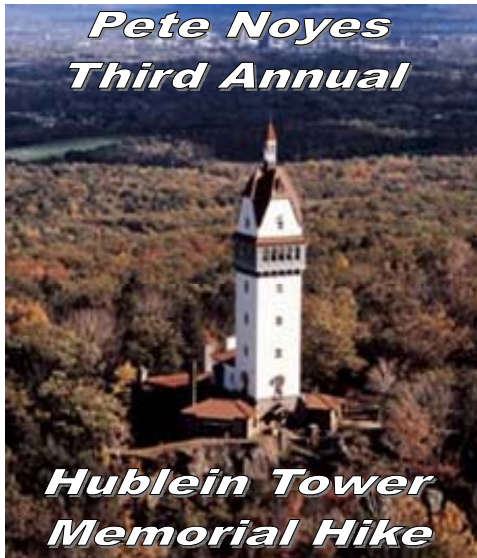
